These are undocumented workers. Not on public assistance. Contributing to society. Turn out people tomorrow at the library. We need white people there. Show support for undocumented workers.

Second topic: The chair of our SD13 convention wasn't treated respectfully or fairly. Unkind things about women not being chairs or that she wasn't doing it right. Everyone makes mistakes. She's young, graduating college. We need young people involved. We need women. We need POC involved. It should not happen here. We need to lift each other up. Give each other a break. Guide our young people.
