Candidate Updates

Heidi Everett - Hello and thank you for the gift from the Golf event. We are doing some great fundraising but not anywhere near where her opponent is. This Friday she will be talking with Tim O'Driscoll on the radio over the noon hour. House Party at the Haider's. Focus on Avon Twp and Holdingford area. She started driving back to Moorhead this last week. Other than that she has been door knocking and phone calling. She will be doing a second newspaper insert. A direct mailer. Radio ads two weeks in late October (through Leighton broadcasting). She has younger voters in her family who participated in the SD13 Day of Action. It was inspiring to see so many people! Thanks to Buzz for the letter to the editor. She is getting a positive response as shown by requests for lawn signs and people saying that they've heard of her.

Jim Read - Thanks for the \$1500 donation from previous meeting and today's \$500 donation. Our campaign is doing well financially but you can always buy more radio and prints ads. We are doing our first mailing to 9,000 households tomorrow. It will be in mailboxes Thursday and Friday. The mailer emphasizes that Jim has been to over 7,000 doors and what he has heard from voters. Jim wants it to be like a dialogue with voters. It was a fun day of Action on Saturday! They have a house party at Mike Sharps with Ron and Myrna Ohmann. Jim will be on the radio with his opponent to debate. Lawn sign update: 150 smaller signs, 200 of the larger signs. Larger signs are all placed. Now that

students are back he is focusing on campus organizing. Jim has been doorknocking to dorms. He has been to a club fair at CSB SJU. This is the group that can win it for us if we mobilize them to vote! They are natural voters. They don't like Trump. They are pro-immigration and diversity. CSB SJU College Democrats are active. State DFL Party is helping his campaign some but the majority of the work is being done by local activists and volunteers. Sunday there is an immigration themed forum this at 2:00 p.m. at St. Boniface church in Cold Spring. To show up is to show support and make a statement.

<u>Joe Perske</u> - [Robert reports] Thanks to everyone who helped on our Saturday SD13 DFL day of action event. We talked to 1,000 people. 85 shifts. 50 volunteers. Joe will be at the Sunday forum at St. Boniface. He's been out door knocking. We plan more days of action. Joe just ordered 500 more lawn signs. He has recycled some of his past signs too!

Tan Todd - [Denise reports] Ian is at a house party up in SD35 today. He is doing really well. They have a few forums coming up. Hosting a SCSU forum. MPR will host a CD6 forum. CD6 DFL is attempting to do outreach. Denise is outreach coordinator for CD6. If you would like to join the LTE club of CD6 (if you monitor the editorials, if you like to write, even if you'd like to be a ghost writer). Ian has done 22 town halls so far. Opponent only 23 since he's been in office. This last year Ian's opponent only hosted one (small venue, poorly planned) town hall. They have limited edition T-shirts available through ActBlue.
